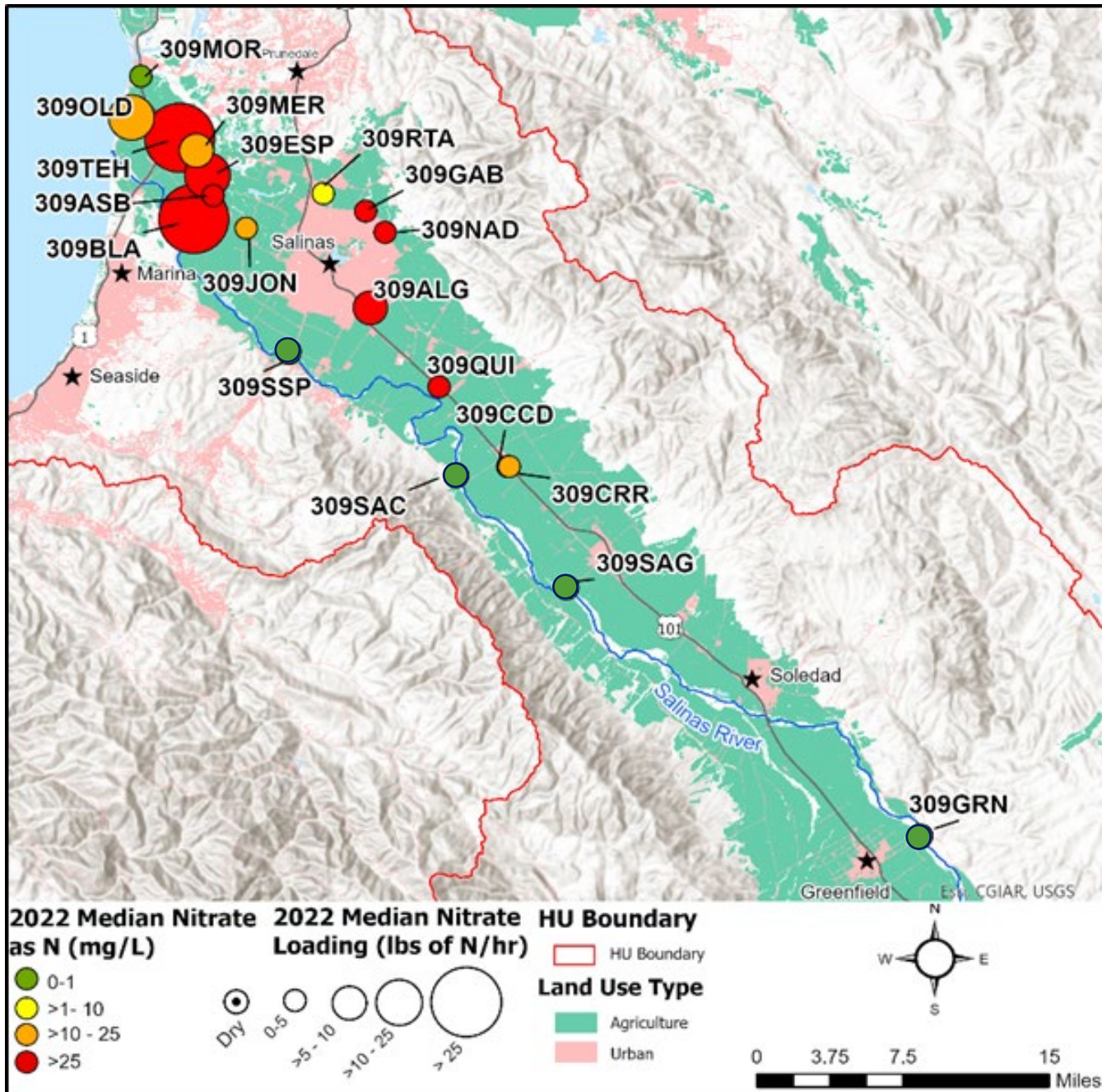

Monitoring Results for Nitrate (as N) in Salinas Area Watersheds

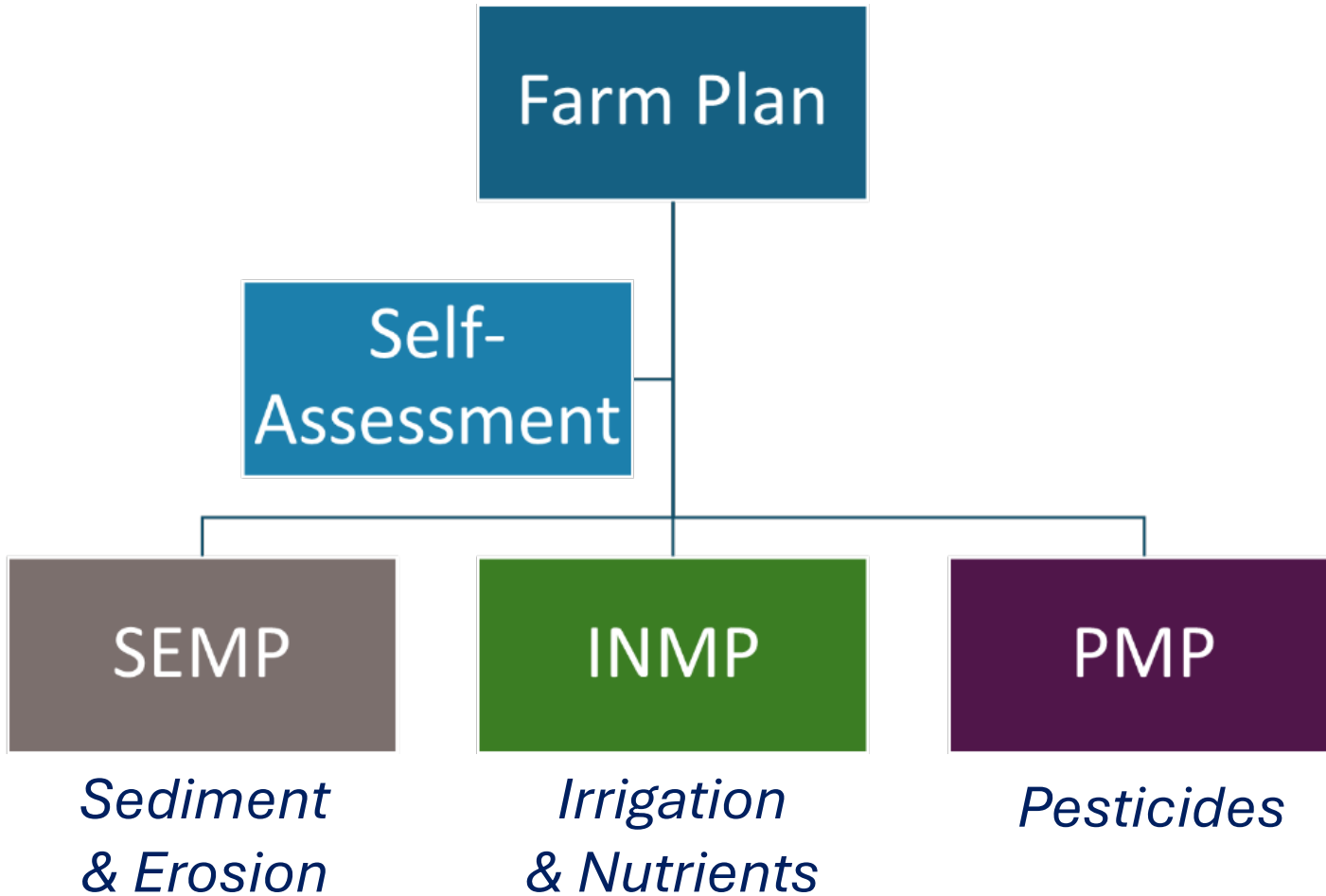




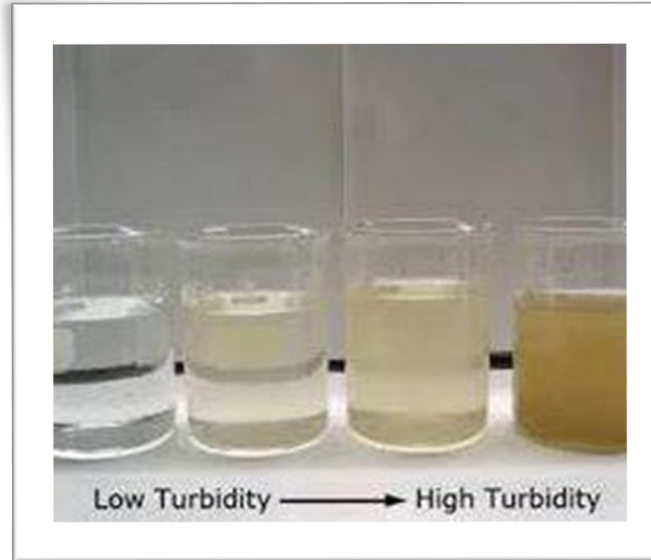
Nitrogen in Groundwater
